FROM YOUR TREASURER

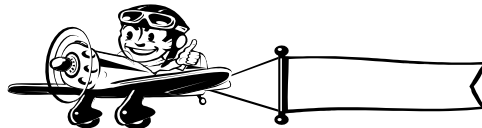
Hope everybody is enjoying the spring weather which has finally arrived. Soon we will be putting our boats and watercraft in the water. A few reminders in that regard:

BEACH CLEANUP DAY

Volunteers Needed! We will be cleaning up the Beach area for the upcoming season. Date is Saturday, May 18th beginning at 9:30 AM. Rain date is Sunday, May 19th. Please come out and help. It shouldn't take too long. We will be cleaning, grading and doing an overall spruce-up of the beach area.

ADOPT THE BEACH FOR A WEEK

We have all seen signs for Adopt-a-Highway. People sign up to "adopt" a two-mile stretch of road and commit to remove the trash from it twice a year.

We would like to do something similar for our community beach. We hope to have residents sign up to take a turn cleaning trash off the beach one time during the week of their choosing. With 550 families in our neighborhood, if enough people sign up, no one should have to take a turn more than once a year.

We will provide trash bags and the filled bags can be left in the trash cans at either end of the beach.

I will commit to manage the calendar, and I will contact the "cleaners" a week before their chosen week, to remind them. I will also contact them again the day before their week begins to give them the trash bags they will need for clean-up.

We will start taking turns the week after the Community Beach Clean-up Day. During the months of December, January and February, we will only clean once each month, since there are usually fewer people using the beach during the winter.

2013 VIRGINIA BOATING SAFETY EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

As a reminder, the safety education requirement continues to change each year. Effective July 1, 2013 the requirements are:

- **PWC- No operators under 14 years of age; All PWC operators must have completed a Virginia approved Boater's Safety course.**
- **Boats - Operators under 40 years of age on July 1, must complete a Virginia Boater's safety course.**
- **Be sure to carry your training certificate/card with you on the water in case you are stopped.**
